

What is the OEF/OIF Post Deployment Integrated Care Clinic?

The OEF/OIF Post Deployment Integrated Care Clinic is a unique clinic designed for the returning combat veteran. Our staff consists of a primary care provider, nurse, psychologist, and social worker. The staff has been trained to provide care for the returning OEF/OIF combat veteran because we understand the needs of combat veterans differ from those of non-combat veterans.



We provide a “One Stop Shop” program so that the OEF/OIF veteran can be seen and evaluated by our staff, all in the same day. If further care is required, we expedite the care of the veteran to the services needed.

We are committed to helping make each service member’s transition from active duty military status to civilian life as smooth as possible.

Hours of operation are 13:00 to 16:00 hours Monday through Friday.


Walk-ins are welcome from 08:00 to 12:00 but will not be seen by our provider until the afternoon.
